Programs: Gleaning Abundance Program

- Fruit harvesting program
- Harvest is split between volunteers, homeowners, and food programs
- In operation since 2014
- Harvest between 15,000 and 25,000 lbs per year
- Increasing number of recipient agencies



Programs: Social Enterprise

- Processing a portion of excess fruit: Freezing or dehydrating
- Selling fruit for snacks to Boys and Girls Club
- Food Literacy component
- Initial start in 2017
- Pilot project in 2018



Programs: Seed Library

- Purchased a winnower and thresher in spring 2017
- Hosted demonstration at Farmers Market
- Seed Cleaning workshop
- Envision lending equipment in exchange for seed donations to library



Programs: Farm to School

- 3 pillars:
 - Healthy local food
 - Hands on learning
 - Community connectedness (KFPC as network)
- 8 schools in Kamloops Region
- Projects include:
 - Composting
 - Microgreens
 - School gardens
 - Snack programs: smoothies and snack chips
 - Celebration of Learning



Programs: Wild Salmon Caravan

- Indigenous led event
- Caravaners travel from ocean to Adam's River
- Purpose to celebrate and call for the protection of Wild Salmon
- KFPC hosted feast and parade organization





Partnerships: Network Meetings

- Once a month potluck
- Individuals and food agencies share information about local food initiatives
- Educational speakers and topics





Partnerships: Community of Practice

- BC Food System Network project
- Connects Food Policy Councils and food agencies with monthly webinars
- Annual gathering and potential for collective action



Partnerships: Food and Social Services agencies



- We aim to connect and recognize other local food agencies
 - Annual Golden Apple Award
 - Invitations to present at network meetings
 - Donating gleaned produce
 - Join other coalitions
 - Connect gleaning volunteers to other projects





Policy: Food and Urban Agriculture Plan

- Active members on the planning committee
- Key partner with the City of Kamloops for Implementation
- Working together on grant applications for various actions identified through FUAP

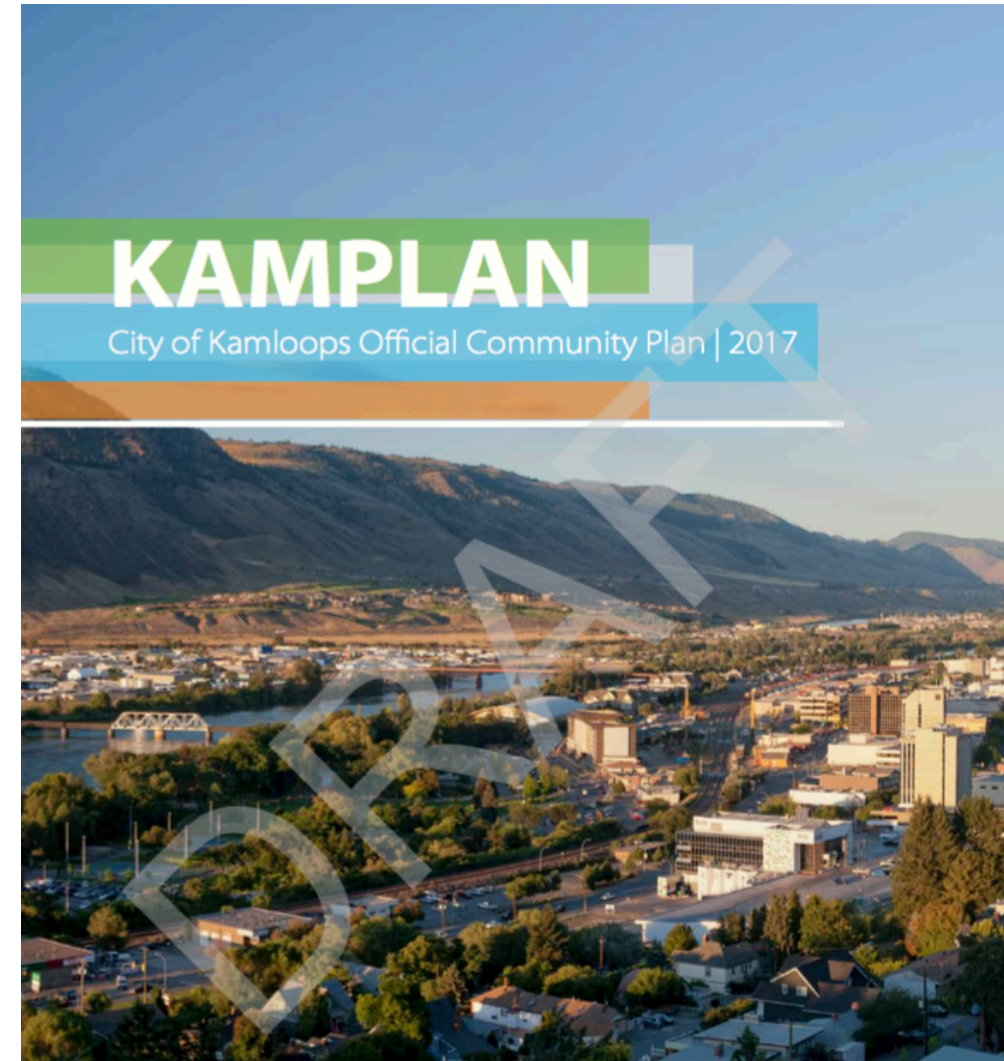

Policy: Official Community Plan

- Advocating for a number of inclusions including food assets as amenities
 - developers can choose to construct community gardens, orchards, kitchens, edible landscaping, food markets, pollinator corridors or onsite composting in exchange for rezoning a property

- TNRD Regional Growth Strategy
- Sustainable Kamloops Plan
- Kamloops Social Plan
- National Food Policy



Indigenous Food Sovereignty

- Requires a shift away from production paradigm
- Changes to case law are important for regional food planning
 - Tsilhqot'in (2014)
 - Title of territory, consent, end to postage stamp theory
- Sovereignty over decisions that impact food sources
 - Wild Salmon Caravan
 - Ex. farmed Salmon, hydro dams, pipelines, genetic modification
